


Six elements building the perfect storm post-2015:


- 1. The epidemiological transition

- 3. Neglect of water & sanitation in heath facilities
- 4. Poor infection prevention & control
- 5. Weak HMIS & disease surveillance
- 6. Emerging antimicrobial resistance

Figure I: Global maternal and neonatal deaths due to infections




## The proportion of deliveries in healthcare institutions in many low-income countries is increasing rapidly
