Aim:

- Orient national stakeholders (government, UN agencies, partners) to incremental water, sanitation and hygiene approaches including through use of the WHO/UNICEF WASHFIT tool
- Train and support the establishment of robust and sustainable water, sanitation, hygiene and waste programs at health care facilities in six target health care facilities

Objectives:

- Present framework for incremental improvements to WASH services in health care facilities
- Provide basic knowledge, skills, and tools to establish WASH programs at facility level
- Support use of Infection Prevention and Control (IPCAF) and WASH FIT tools
- Develop facility level Action plans for incremental WASH improvement
